It is very important that you tell your physician or dentist that you have a Total Joint Replacement, a partial Joint Replacement (MAKOplasty or ConforMIS), or any other Joint Resurfacing several days prior to your receiving any of the following treatments. This is because you may need to be put on an antibiotic treatment beforehand as a preventive for infection.
